On 06/09/2026 at approximately 8:12 a.m., I, Chief Aten, was on duty and patrolling in my marked patrol vehicle while monitoring traffic on Route 48 just north of Casey's General Store. A white GMC pickup truck passed my location, and my in-car license plate reader alerted on the vehicle for a suspended registration.

I pulled behind the vehicle, activated my emergency lights, and initiated a traffic stop at the intersection of Route 48 and 700 North Road. I requested confirmation from CCSO, which verified that the vehicle's registration was suspended and had expired in

I exited my patrol vehicle and approached the GMC from the passenger side. I identified myself and advised the driver of the reason for the traffic stop. I then became aware that the driver and all occupants spoke very little English. Using Google Translate, I again explained the reason for the stop and requested the driver's license or identification.

The driver provided what appeared to be a passport identification document and was identified as DOB. I asked the driver whether he or anyone else in the vehicle possessed a valid driver's license. The driver stated that no one in the vehicle had a valid driver's license. The passengers were DOB (and)

Sgt. Goebel of the Christian County Sheriff's Office assisted with the traffic stop. CCSO conducted record checks on all three occupants of the vehicle, and no records were located for any of them.

I advised the occupants that the vehicle would be towed. Sgt. Goebel and I offered to transport them to Casey's in Morrisonville, where they could wait for their employer and the registered owner of the vehicle to pick them up. I transported the occupants, along with some of their personal belongings, to Casey's while Sgt. Goebel remained with the vehicle and awaited the arrival of the tow company.

Upon arrival at Casey's, I advised the driver that I was issuing a verbal warning for operating a vehicle without a valid driver's license and for the suspended registration. I also informed him that he could not legally operate a motor vehicle until he obtained a valid driver's license. The driver indicated that he understood and thanked me.

I then returned to the traffic stop location and completed an inventory sheet for the vehicle. KerTow's took possession of the vehicle.
