

STATEMENT:

U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) is coordinating with state and federal officials to offer any assistance needed in the furtherance of the prosecution tied to the tragic 2019 El Paso Walmart shooting.

If the need arises, the agencies will remain in coordination with ICE to determine whether it is necessary that Rosa [REDACTED] be physically present in the United States.

Neither her nor her attorney made known to ICE her coordination with local law enforcement regarding the 2019 shooting case prior to her removal on Jan. 29.

Non-citizen victims and witnesses of crimes may seek certain benefits allowing them to remain in the United States. According to checks performed by ICE prior to [REDACTED] removal, none of those benefits were indicated.
