OUTREACH ACTIVITIES-

EVENTS WITH COMMUNITY ORGANIZATIONS:

IRSC Public Media hosts tours for interested individuals during regular business and will schedule group tours to fit the needs of the group visiting outside of business hours. These tours explain the operations of the stations and discuss career opportunities in broadcasting. Regular tours include the local chapter of the National Federation for the Blind and the Ft. Pierce Ham Radio Club.

The General Manager, Marketing Specialist, and Programming/Traffic Coordinator attended the Treasure Coast Hurricane Preparedness Expo on July 9th, where they discussed emergency information and career opportunities in broadcasting with over one thousand attendees.

EVENTS WITH EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS:

WQCS/WQCP/WQJS hosts tours for educational organizations and groups. These tours explain the operations of the stations and discuss career opportunities in broadcasting:

- October 27, 2021 15 Middle School Students from Educational Talent Search (ETS).
- June 14, 2022 40 High School students from the CROP program.
- June 16, 2022 25 Middle School Students from Clark Advanced Leaning Center.
- July 6, 2022 8 High School Students from the CROP Summer program.
- September 1, 2022 18 College Students from the Digital Media course at IRSC.

Pioneer Radio is a student-produced program that airs on IRSC Public Media in an effort to bring the voices of the campus to the community. This club is for students who want to get involved in creating media segments for the show. Interviews are recorded for production in the IRSC Public Media studios. Students in the Pioneer Radio Club use various technology at the radio station – in-studio and remote recording equipment, and computer editing software to generate their final product that provides a service to the community of listeners.

In August 2022, during "Club Rush" (an IRSC sponsored conference for students), IRSC Public Media spoke with over 150 current IRSC students about career opportunities in broadcasting. Over thirty expressed interest in joining Pioneer Radio for the upcoming semester.

SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM:

IRSC Public Media continues to offer the Madison Hodges Scholarship to be awarded to students who wish to continue their higher education in a major focused on media. The Madison Hodges Scholarship provides students with the opportunity to reach their academic goals. A student received a \$500.00 scholarship to attend Indian River State College for the 2021-2022 academic year.

MENTORSHIP PROGRAMS:

An Underwriting Sales Representative serves as a mentor in the L.E.A.P./Men Of Color/Women Of Color Program at IRSC, to assist first-year college students (in particular those of color) develop a solid academic and social foundation. Formerly in the Minority Affairs Department, these groups also tour WQCS and learn about job opportunities and careers in media.

TRAINING FOR STATION PERSONNEL:

The General Manager, Marketing Specialist, and two Underwriting Account Executives attended the Public Media Broadcasters Association yearly convention. This year's conference was done remotely due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

The Marketing Specialist, and two Underwriting Sales Associates attended the Public Media Development and Marketing Convention. This year's event was also done remotely due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

EEO AND ANTI-DISCRIMINATION TRAINING FOR STATION MANAGEMENT AND STAFF:

In May and June 2022, the entire staff of IRSC Public Media took part in and passed the CPB mandated Harassment Training, as a condition of receiving the Grant for FY2022.
