**SUMMARY:**

On Friday 02/20/2026 at approximately 3:30pm I was contacted by Antrim County Sheriff Hoch and Undersheriff Lasater regarding a possible complaint involving the Antrim County Clerk's office. Due to the complaint involving a county employee, they requested MSP handle the investigation.

On Monday 02/23/26 I met with Sheriff Hoch and Undersheriff Lasater to get a synopsis of the allegations. I was informed that on Thursday 02/19/26 there was a board of commissioners meeting that began at 6:30pm. During this time, the county clerk was in attendance at the meeting. Also, during this time a county maintenance employee who cleans the county building observed Randy Bishop (County Clerk's husband) in the clerk's office [REDACTED]. During this same time frame, [REDACTED]. Following this synopsis, I met with the County Administrator (Jeremy Scott) in his office to discuss this further. This complaint is open pending additional investigation / interviews.

**INTERVIEW COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR:**

On 02/23/26 following my meeting with the Sheriff and Undersheriff I spoke with the County Administrator Jeremy Scott in his office. Jeremy reiterated the issue I was informed of by the Sheriff. Jeremy advised on Thursday night, during the board meeting Randy Bishop was observed in the Clerk's office [REDACTED]. This was relayed to him by [REDACTED] who works for Antrim County maintenance [REDACTED]. Jeremy advised county IT reported [REDACTED]. Jeremy then provided me with a printout of an audit log from county IT [REDACTED]. This audit log was scanned at the Gaylord post and placed on a disc and placed in post property.

Jeremy was also asked about restricted access to the office itself. Jeremy explained that in order to access the clerk's office, you need an access badge which scans and allows access to the office. There is an audit log of who scan their access badge for entry into that particular office throughout the county building. Jeremy provided me with a printout of the audit log on the date in question (02-19-26) from 3pm until the end of the day. The only two access badges that had entry into the clerk's office after 5pm that day were [REDACTED] (for cleaning) and Victoria Bishop (County Clerk). [REDACTED]

At this point, Jeremy was unaware if [REDACTED]. He was going to work with their IT department to see if they could find anything else out. It was also discussed that Jeremy was going to send an email to the clerk regarding this incident and remind her of the "Acceptable Use of Information and Technology Policy" for the county. Below is the correspondence between the two of them.

On 02/25/2026 I spoke with D/Sgt. Kirschner of the Michigan State Police Computer Crimes Unit. I provided D/Sgt. Kirschner a synopsis of the complaint asking if he believed CCU could obtain any additional information off the computer that county IT was unable to obtain. D/Sgt. Kirschner explained that they would be able to see when files were last accessed, but that would be about it. And due to the length in time from the incident until now, having the clerk accessing those programs and files in the normal course of her business, it would likely not be beneficial as they would not be able to tell any more than that.

**INTERVIEW [REDACTED]**

On 02/25/26 at approximately 11:30am I spoke with [REDACTED] at the MSP Gaylord post Bellaire detachment. I began the interview by confirming her identity and asking how long she had been employed with the county. [REDACTED] advised she has been a "janitor" in maintenance at the county for approximately 2 years. She is responsible for cleaning the county building (taking out trash, mopping floors, and general cleaning).

[REDACTED] confirmed that she was working the night of 02/19/26. She advised that she went through the county building and took out all the trash, which is what she typically does before beginning to vacuum. When she went back into the clerk's office all the lights were off. She flipped the light on and went to plug in her vacuum where she normally does. When she plugged it in and bent back up, she noticed a man [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] advised she did not say anything to him, or he did not say anything to her. She advised [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] advised she went about her vacuuming and then left the office. [REDACTED] thought this happened sometime between 6p and 6:30p.

I asked [REDACTED] if she knew who the man at the clerk's desk was. She advised she could not recall his name, but she knew it was the clerk's husband. She advised he had been pointed out several times to her before as being the clerk's husband. [REDACTED] clarified that after she noticed him in the clerk's office, she did not go back in the office. She vacuumed around the cubicles in the main office but did not go back in the clerk's office until she knew they were gone (after the meeting). [REDACTED] She could not tell [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] advised she [REDACTED] reported it to her co-worker [REDACTED] (also in maintenance). [REDACTED] told her she needed to report it, so she spoke to her supervisor (Carrie) who took her to Jeremy Scott to report it the following morning.

**INTERVIEW ANNETTE MARCUS:**

On 02/26/26 at approximately 9am I spoke with Annette Marcus at the MSP Gaylord post Bellaire detachment. I began the interview by confirming her identity and asking her what her official title was. Annette advised she was the chief deputy clerk for Antrim county. She has been in that official role since January of 2025 appointed by Victoria Bishop. I asked Annette if she had reported something to county IT. Annette advised that on Friday morning 02/20/26 when she went into the office, she asked Victoria how the meeting went as she did not have a chance to watch it as she was busy doing something else. [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] Annette advised she [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] Annette went on to explain that you are only allowed access to what your badge allows. Annette could not access the treasures office as she works for the clerk and vice versa. She can only access the clerk's office after hours with her badge.

Annette advised she decided to go upstairs and report it [REDACTED] knowing that they have the QVF or "qualified voter file" in their office. She was wondering [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] Annette went on to explain the QVF and how only 3 employees in their office have access to it.

Annette went on to explain [REDACTED] Annette advised the key people who work on the voter registration are the township clerks. They need a signature for each and every voter in their township so in the event the computers go down and they can't verify it online, they can match the card file so the election can continue. Annette went on to explain that on the QVF, when someone dies there is a section on the QVF that says "challenge" and a section that says "status". Annette advised that when they are made aware of a death, or someone moving, they get into the QVF and "challenge" that person's status under whatever category they are challenging (deceased, moved, etc.). This action prompts a message to the township clerk that the challenged individual resides in to verify the challenge. Once that challenge is confirmed, the township clerk will go in the QVF and change the "status" of that individual and pull their "voter card" from their file. It's Annette's understanding that the county clerk does not go directly to the "status" section of the QVF and make the changes. This does not provide the township clerks with an opportunity to verify anything or remove the voter registration card from their file, as it automatically removes

On 03/12/2026 at approximately 2:50pm I met with Kearney Township Clerk Michelle Valuet at the MSP Bellaire Detachment. The following is a synopsis of that interview and not a word for word transcription.

Michelle began by confirming her position as the Kearney township Clerk. Michelle advised she has held this position since 2020. I asked Michelle if she had any issues or concerns with the Clerk's office at the County level. Michelle advised [REDACTED] Michelle advised just recently she went into the QVF and noticed one of her voters that was now deceased had been marked cancelled. Michelle advised there is a process that they are supposed to go through. Michelle went on to explain the process, where if the County Clerk becomes aware that someone is deceased. They (County Clerk) are supposed to put that person in "challenged" status. It then goes to the Township Clerk, and the Township Clerk is supposed to cancel that person. Michelle advised you can tell who makes the change in the QVF as it states who made the change. Sometimes the state does it, but for the Counties and Townships, there is a process.

Michelle advised [REDACTED] Michelle advised [REDACTED] Michelle also spoke about the meeting / presentation from a 3<sup>rd</sup> party source regarding a database for voters. This is the same meeting Judith was talking about [REDACTED] Michelle advised she did not go along with it and notified the Bureau of Elections. She believed this meeting took place in September of 2025.

I asked Michelle if any of the changes she has observed in the QVF that Vickie has made have been incorrect. As if she is moving or adding people that should not be removed or added. Michelle advised that has not been the case for her. She has not seen anyone removed or added that should not be from the QVF.

Michelle did not have any other issues or concerns regarding the County Clerk. This concluded my interview with Michelle.

**INTERVIEW VICTORIA BISHOP:**

On 04/22/2026 at approximately 12:40pm I met with Antrim County Clerk Victoria Bishop at the MSP Bellaire Detachment. The following is a synopsis of that interview and not a word for word transcription. Prior to any questioning, I advised Vickie that she was not under arrest and was under no obligation to speak with me. She came to the detachment on her own free will and was free to leave whenever she wanted.

I started by confirming Vickie's position as the Antrim County Clerk. She advised that she has held that position since January of 2024. I took Vickie back to Thursday February 19<sup>th</sup> during the board of commissioners meeting. I asked if anyone from the county had spoken with Vickie reference that day. Vickie advised she received an email from the County Administrator (Jeremy) asking who was in her office. She advised him that it was her husband. Vickie further went on to describe that she was told [REDACTED] [REDACTED] She reported that to Jeremy and he asked her about it.

I asked Vickie why her husband was in her office. Vickie advised he was waiting for a phone call. Vickie had to do the Clerk duties during the meeting, so she turned the meeting on her computer so he could watch it while waiting for his phone call. He did not want to sit in the meeting live, and have it interrupted by a phone call. I asked Vickie if he typically attends the meetings in person. Vickie said sometimes, but on this particular night [REDACTED] he was there.

I confirmed once again with Vickie that she turned her computer on. She said yes, and then she turned the meeting on which was being streamed on the commissioners Facebook. I asked Vickie if her husband typically has access to her computer and she responded with "no". I asked Vickie if he knew her login information or password. She responded with "no". I asked Vickie if he has ever been in her office unattended before. Vickie advised [REDACTED]

I asked Vickie to explain how the QVF typically works. Vickie advised that only her and Annette Marcus, her Deputy Clerk have access to the QVF. Vickie advised the QVF is a state based system but her access to the QVF is limited to Antrim County only. She advised that typically every month, the state sends her a list of people who died or moved in Antrim County. She sends them to the Township Clerks to remove them from the QVF as that is part of their duties. After Vickie confirmed she does not remove anyone from the QVF, this essentially ended our interview. Vickie provided contact information for her husband Randy for me to set up an interview with him.
