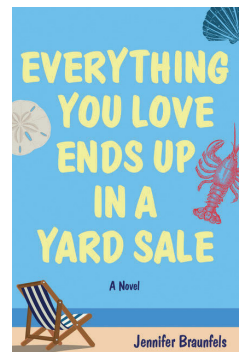
Everything You Love Ends Up in a Yard Sale this July

Program Notes...

Maine Public's celebration of the nation's semiquincentennial continues throughout July! To set the stage, Maine Public Classical will embark on a three-album journey across the July 4th weekend. These three recent releases give musical life to the ideas of the American Dream, the American Road, and American Voices. On Maine Public Television, we'll bring you **A Capitol Fourth: 250th Weekend Celebration** on Friday evening, July 3. On Saturday, the 4th, it's the premiere of **America Made in Virginia: 250 Years Together**.

This celebration comes to us from historic Colonial Williamsburg and features musical performances, tributes to the history of our nation, and a giant fireworks display. Also be sure to check out our local offering, **Assignment Maine: America@250**, airing throughout the holiday weekend.

On Maine Public Television beginning Tuesday, July 7, **Nick Knowles: Heritage Rescue** follows a team of highly skilled master craftspeople who set about to return crumbling UK castles to their former glory. And on Saturday afternoon, July 18, we'll bring you the **Maine Shrine Lobster Bowl Classic**, an All-Star football game featuring more than 140 top graduating players and cheerleaders from more than 60 high school programs across Maine.

Later in the month on **Maine Public Classical**, local artistry has pride of place on our airwaves. As Shakespearean drama takes center stage in Portland, host Emily Duncan Wilson talks to Camilla Tassi, projection designer for Opera Maine's summer production of *Romeo et Juliette*, and the company's Artistic Director, Dona D. Vaughn, in **State of the Art** on July 19 and 20. Host Sarah Tuttle keeps the Bard's tale alive on **Stage & Screen** with a variety of depictions of the ill-fated young lovers, from Gounod to Prokofiev throughout the week of July 20.

Nick Knowles:
Heritage Rescue

Begins Tuesday, July 7, at 10:00 pm

Many of the U.K.'s finest castles and palaces are slowly deteriorating, their stories and grandeur in danger of disappearing with them. In this six-part contemporary restoration series, host Nick Knowles follows a team of expert builders and artisans who have

embarked on returning these treasured, but troubled, historic buildings, to their former splendor. A castle in Yorkshire is in danger of the lead roofs caving in. At one of Britain's finest "fairy tale" castles, workers take on the restoration of two irreplaceable hand painted ceilings. At Exeter Cathedral, it's the weather that is damaging the incredible stonework and statues. Multiple challenges in saving these once-magnificent buildings include preserving 700-year-old stained-glass, stopping water from streaming into buildings, roofs that are collapsing, stone exteriors that are disintegrating, and oak beams that threaten to collapse at any moment. 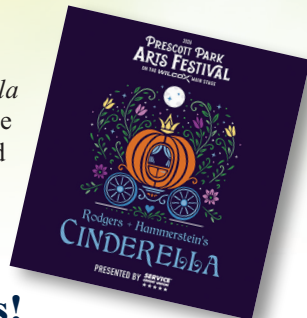


It's Maine International Film Festival time!

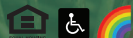
