Outreach Initiatives

Internship.

A program to assist members of the community to acquire skills needed for broadcast employment. KNKX has multiple professional internship opportunities throughout the year, continuing an established record from the time of the previous Licensee of station interns proceeding to careers in public broadcasting. In the time period covered by this report, individuals participated in internships in areas covering broadcast support, promotions, fund raising, and customer service. The following staff members worked with our interns: Brenda Goldstein-Young and Carol Handley.

School of Jazz, a unique educational program (Category 16). Since 2005, School of Jazz has demonstrated a commitment to jazz education; in fact, it's one of the cornerstones of KNKX's mission as the station's signature community outreach program. School of Jazz provides mentorship, learning and performance opportunities to Western Washington middle school, high school, and college jazz students, as well as exposure to careers in jazz format radio broadcasting (more broadly, music format). Several times a year, we invite a student jazz combo and professional mentor to perform live on the air. And every month throughout the year a guest student DJ shares an hour of their favorite jazz on the air with host Abe Beeson. The enthusiasm these students feel for jazz is contagious, as they discuss their favorite songs and why they love this style of music with inspiring, and often wise insights. Since its inception, School of Jazz has directly impacted nearly 4,000 jazz students, band directors, and professional musicians. In the years ahead, KNKX strives to expand School of Jazz to provide one-of-a- kind learning and performance experiences to even more students, both in our studios and live "on location" in the schools and at events. In 2022, KNKX recorded studio sessions with four student groups, two of which took place at a jazz venue in North Bend (east of Seattle). So far in 2023, KNKX has recorded three student groups. KNKX hired a student group to perform at KNKX's biggest event of the year in August 2023: the open house at the station's brand-new downtown Seattle studios, as well as employing student "buskers" from Seattle JazzED to perform outside our studios in front of a jazz mural. As of this writing (early September 2023) we are formulating a plan to record two of Seattle's top student programs (Roosevelt and Garfield high schools) and showcase them in KNKX's Public Radio Music Day (noncom MUSIC Alliance) program which will be shared with public stations nationwide and globally via social media.
