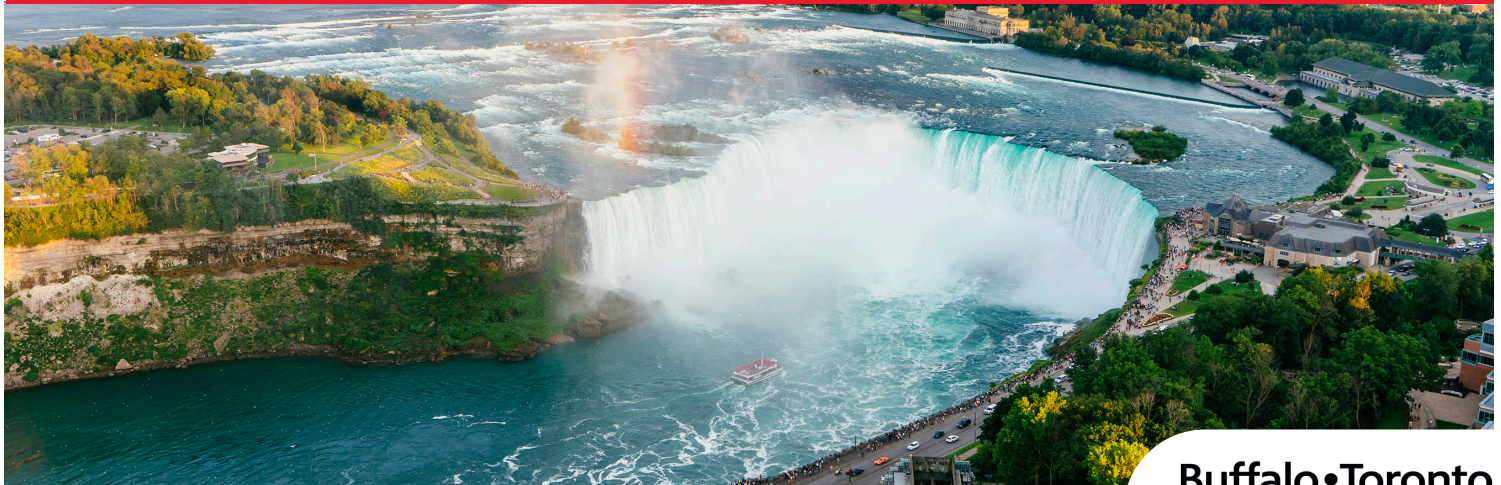

AAA Group Travel activity levels are designed to help travelers select the pace that is right for them. - 1** = **RELAXED** – Leisurely pace; shorter touring days; some physical activity required, including independently boarding and disembarking a motorcoach.
- 2** = **COMFORTABLE** – Easy pace; some stairs and standing; short duration walks typically on level terrains.
- 3** = **ACTIVE** – Moderate pace; good mobility needed; stairs and prolonged standing for more than 2 hours at a time; some longer days involving early mornings and/or late evenings; some walking on varied terrain. This Activity Level is not recommended for travelers with mobility issues such as someone who uses a cane, walker, or wheelchair.
- 4** = **CHALLENGING** – Fast pace; frequent physically challenging activities; walking on varied terrain and/or up to two miles at a time; longer tour days. This Activity Level is not recommended for travelers with serious medical conditions.
- 5** = **STRENUOUS** – Vigorous pace; frequent strenuous activities; extensive walking; longer tour days; walking on varied terrain.
