## Mrs. Wilson

Actress Ruth Wilson stars as her own grandmother Alison in the true story of a woman's search for her husband's real identity on "Mrs. Wilson," airing in two thrilling episodes on **Masterpiece**.

At the outset of World War II, Alison McKelvie met and fell in love with Major Alexander Wilson when they were both working for the secret service. A popular author of spy novels, Alec was then doing real intelligence work for the war effort.

Iain Glen costars as Alec, a seductive operative in the mold of James Bond. It was Alec's novels that pioneered the character of the debonair spy, based on his own qualities. This personality type was later exploited by Ian Fleming in his Bond books.

"Mrs. Wilson" opens in 1963, when Alison and Alec have been married for more than 20 years. Shortly after Alec suffers a fatal heart attack, a grief-stricken Alison is confronted by a woman claiming to be Alec's real wife, Gladys. Alison is also ap-

## OTTOMANS VERSUS CHRISTIANS:

### THE BATTLE FOR EUROPE

**Ottomans Versus Christians: The Battle for Europe** travels to the Balkans, Eastern Europe, and the former Soviet Union, where the bloody power struggle between Christian Europe and the Muslim Ottoman Empire lasted for nearly three centuries. This conflict was more than just a fight over wealth and territory, it was a battle for cultural and religious supremacy.

The three-part series presents an epic tale that traces the Empire back to when it first began and explores its expansion into Europe. Although the exact date is unknown, the Ottoman Empire is said to have come about when its founder, Osman I, had a prophetic dream instructing him to take authority over the world. After gaining control of Anatolia, the Ottomans then set their sights on expanding their Empire.

The series explores the first battles the Ottomans fought to gain control of the Balkans in the 1300s, then moves to the Empire's Golden Age and fateful siege of Vienna in the 1600s, and concludes with the struggles between the Ottomans and the Tsarist Russians that resulted in the Crimean War in the 1800s, and the Empire's transformation into the modern Turkish state.

Host Julian Davison uncovers the vast legacy of the Ottoman Empire, its impressive architecture, and the continuing repercussions of this legendary clash of civilizations.

## King Arthur's Lost Kingdom

In the fifth century, the future of Britain hung in the balance. After four centuries of Roman occupation and leadership, the Romans up and left, leaving the nation vulnerable to an invading Anglo-Saxon horde—or at least that's what the fragmentary historical texts record. The truth is no one really knows what happened, and this pivotal moment in history has been shrouded in mystery until now.

**Ottomans Versus Venetians: The Battle for Crete**, a half-hour film, reveals how the island was claimed by the Ottomans in 1669 after one of the longest sieges in military history. For the Venetians, their only hope for victory over the larger Ottoman army in Crete lay in successfully starving it of supplies and reinforcements. Hence the war turned into a series of naval encounters between the two navies and their allies.

The Ottomans were victorious and despite many rebellions by Christian Cretans, the island was to remain part of the Ottoman Empire until the very end of the 19th century.

Housewife, fashion designer, and beloved family member, Annette Ontell lived seven decades in the same house at 306 Hollywood Avenue, Hillside, New

Jersey. When Annette died, she left behind heaps of clutter—dusty fragments of an unassuming life.

What to keep and what to throw away? In search of some way to quantify the emotional value of Annette's belongings, the siblings begin an exhaustive 11 month quest to catalog everything in the slumbering house. Through her mess, Annette blooms into a vivid presence.

Toothbrush by toothbrush, the Bogaríns catalogue Annette's possessions. Under

their scrutiny, each object is at once mundane and mysterious, like six cans of Band-Aids filled with pennies and 50-year-old toilet paper. To unsentimental eyes, the moldy paper is trash. To people who loved Annette—and the Bogaríns dearly do—it's something entirely different.

The siblings fill the backyard with several rows of mismatched chairs—the sign of someone who embraced color and chaos? They paper the roof and shingles with their family's old clothing, shirts and dresses lying lifeless as if to emphasize their owners are absent.

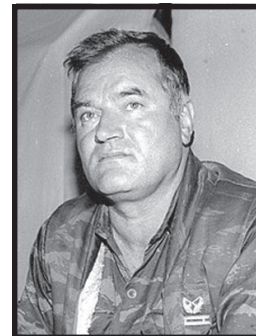
For each of the last ten years of her 93-year life, Annette was interviewed for one hour by her film-obsessed grandchildren. In one riotous scene, Annette is cajoled into wearing one of her old dresses. Despite her best efforts, she can no longer fit her 80-year-old frame into the 50-year-old dress. Annette wages a losing battle with the unforgiving fabric. It's an achingly human moment that captures the joy of living and the melancholy of loss, so emblematic of the power of "306 Hollywood."

Ultimately, a profound reflection on how we examine and deal with the past, "306 Hollywood" can also be viewed as a quirky instruction manual on how to live in the present.

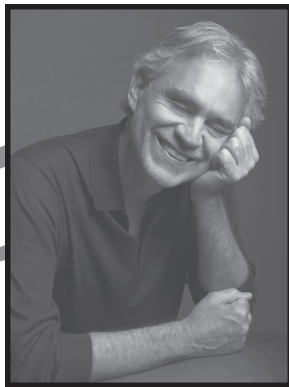


