



A Fond Farewell to Two Public Radio Greats

Two public radio greats are hanging up the headphones. Garrison Keillor retired as host of *A Prairie Home Companion* in July, and *Michael Feldman's Whad'Ya Know?* stopped production in June.

Garrison Keillor hosted the very first broadcast of *A Prairie Home Companion* in 1974. The show underwent some changes over the years – including a hiatus, a temporary name change (to *American Radio Company of the Air*), and a few different home bases. With musical performances, comedy sketches, and Garrison Keillor's signature monologue, "The News from Lake Wobegon," the program has won the hearts of public radio listeners of all ages.

According to Keillor, "When the show started, it was something funny to do with my friends, and then it became an achievement that I hoped would be successful, and now it's a good way of life."

Michael Feldman created *Whad'Ya Know?* in 1985. The two-hour weekly show featured comedy, interviews, and a weekly quiz.

"It may be called Michael Feldman's Whad'Ya Know?, but it really has been Everybody Who Listens And Comes To The Shows's Whad'Ya Know?. It's

the listeners at home and those who show up that make the show - I am just a conduit," Feldman joked. "I will be forever grateful to everybody - and their kids! - who made the show so much a part of their lives and of mine. Thank you so much!"

Chris Thile to Host A Prairie Home Companion

Beginning in fall of 2016, Chris Thile will take over as host of A Prairie Home Companion.

"I grew up with the show," says Thile. "I take this opportunity, this job, immensely seriously and with great awe."

Thile is among the most highly acclaimed musicians of his generation. A singer, mandolin player, and multiinstrumentalist, he has been in the bands Nickel Creek and Punch Brothers. In 1996 at the age of 15, Thile made his *Prairie Home Companion* debut, in a broadcast that showcased remarkable young artists.

Twenty years later, Garrison Keillor says he is happy to pass the torch:

"Chris is my man. He is, I think, the great bluegrass performer of our time and he is a beautiful jazz player. There just isn't anything he can't do - and he is very enthusiastic about live radio."
