

KUNC News Internship Program

KUNC's news internship program (unpaid) provides a hands-on opportunity to acquire the fundamental skills of interviewing, news writing and radio audio production.

The intern must be currently enrolled in an academic course or program, and documentation that the student is receiving academic credit for the internship must be provided.

The intern must be available for a minimum of 10 hours per week at the radio station in Greeley to participate in the KUNC news internship program. And while we will consider all internship applications, students must be able to meet their required hours Monday through Friday between 9:00 a.m. – 5:00p.m.

The KUNC news internship involves being assigned a newscast story and preparing it for on-air and online.

Work includes: researching stories, finding sources, conducting interviews, writing copy, editing sound bites and preparing the story for on-air and online.
