The camera has been the Crown's confidante, messenger – and nemesis, from official portraits to tabloid snapshots. Lucy Worsley takes viewers through the story of the royal photograph, showing how the royal family collaborated with generations of photographers to create images that reinvented the British monarchy.

Going back to the mid-19th century, Lucy looks at the earliest photographs of Queen Victoria and Prince Albert, taken at a time when monarchies across Europe were under threat. Photography rescued them, showing the British royals as a family rather than aloof rulers. This insider's approach has been continued by royals since then. Princess Diana used her image to focus attention on her message, and younger royals like Catherine, Duchess of Cambridge, have sought to exert much tighter control over how their images are taken and used.
