Lucy Worsley's Royal Photo Album

FROM QUEEN VICTORIA TO PRINCESS DIANA to Prince Harry, the royal family has shaped their image with photography. The camera has been the Crown's confidante, messenger – and nemesis, from official portraits to tabloid snapshots. Lucy Worsley takes viewers through the story of the royal photograph, showing how the royal family collaborated with generations of photographers to create images that reinvented the British monarchy.

Going back to the mid-19th century, Lucy looks at the earliest photographs of Queen Victoria and Prince Albert, taken at a time when monarchies across Europe were under threat. Photography rescued them, showing the British royals as a family rather than aloof rulers. This insider's approach has been continued by royals since then. Princess Diana used her image to focus attention on her message, and younger royals like Catherine, Duchess of Cambridge, have sought to exert much tighter control over how their images are taken and used. 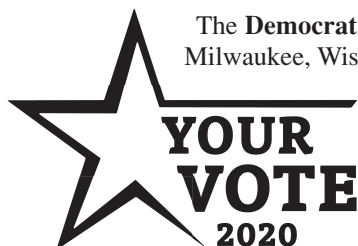

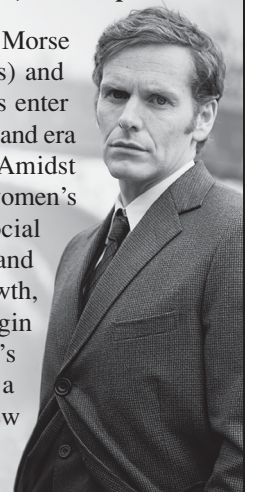

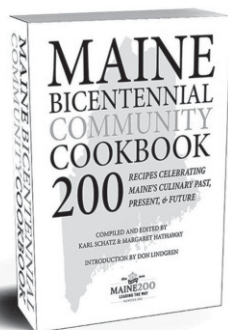
They won in the Feature News Report Category for a piece done on the National Audubon Society's Project

Puffin – an unusual seabird restoration project that got its start on Eastern Egg Rock in the 1970s. Every summer, a handful of interns and research assistants are selected from hundreds of applicants to camp in primitive conditions on this tiny, treeless island several miles off midcoast Maine and evaluate the bird population. Susan and Brian covered the story from every angle, from the program's leaders to the volunteers and captured the spirit of the work being done and the resulting camaraderie between all involved. ■
