Streaming in-car:

Listeners who want to hear WEKU online in their cars can do so if their car stereo has Bluetooth capability or by using an mp3 jack to plug their phone in directly.

You can play WEKU Classical from the WEKU Mobile app that you can download for iphones at the Apple App story or for Android devices at Google Play. You can also use your browser on your smartphone at www.weku.org, click on the arrow on the right side of the page by the audio player to open up WEKU Classical. Then press the play button and you are listening.

WEKU online broadcasts at 64/128 kilobytes (kb) online which means the signal quality is excellent. **Listeners who use**WEKU online may incur data usage charges on their cellular mobile plans if they are not connected to wireless internet. However, data used for audio streaming is considered minimal.

Data Usage Example: Listeners who tune in for 36 hours on their mobile device at 64kb would use 1 gigabyte (gb) of data. 18 hours at 128kb would also use a total of 1 gigabyte of data. By comparison, one hour of streamed HD video would use the same 1 gb of data.
