

FOOD INSECURITY

Food insecurity refers to the USDA's measure of lack of regular access to enough food for an active, healthy life for all household members and limited or uncertain availability of nutritionally adequate foods.

THE POVERTY MEASURE

The federal poverty guideline for a family or household with 4 persons is \$23,850.

MAP THE MEAL GAP

Map the Meal Gap's food insecurity rates are determined using data from the 2009-2013 Current Population Survey on individuals in food insecure households; data from the 2013 American Community Survey on median household incomes, poverty rates, and race and ethnic demographics; and 2013 data from the Bureau of Labor Statistics on unemployment rates.
