

What's In a Tweet?

You may be quite familiar with online social networking, but for those of you who aren't, here is a little primer on those tech words everyone is throwing around, how WVPE is involved and how you can become involved.



WAYS TO LISTEN ONLINE

Live Stream: Listen to audio as it is broadcasted live. Click on the "Listen Live" button at www.wvpe.org to catch WVPE's live stream. It does not require any special media player.

Download: Save audio files (usually in mp3 format) on to your computer's hard drive and play them through a media player, like Winamp or QuickTime. You can download from WVPE's Audio Archive by clicking the "Programs" button on our homepage.

Podcast: Use a podcatcher like iTunes or Miro to subscribe to a podcast of your favorite program. Your podcatcher will then automatically download new files in the series when they are released. Check out our "Podcasts" link under the Programs tab on the WVPE Web site (www.wvpe.org).

SOCIAL NETWORKING WITH WVPE

Social Networking sites are places where persons with similar interests communicate with each other, usually by chat or message boards. Currently, WVPE has a presence on Facebook, Twitter and MySpace, a few of the most popular sites.

Twitter is a free social networking and micro-blogging service that enables its users to send and read messages known as tweets. Tweets are text-based posts of up to 140 characters displayed on the author's profile page and delivered to the author's subscribers who are known as followers.

MySpace became the most popular social networking site in the United States in June 2006. Though still very popular, MySpace was overtaken internationally by main competitor Facebook in April 2008. www.myspace.com/wvpe
