WVPE's Harvey "Ole Harv" Stauffer has been "Testifying to the Blues" for 25 years. To celebrate this milestone, WVPE is hosting a party on Nov. 15, at Riverside Terrace in Mishawaka.

Though he started as a fill-in host, with *The Blues Revue*, Stauffer created an institution at WVPE. His love for the blues began at 15 when he bought BB King's *Live at the Cook County Jail*.

Part of Stauffer's popularity is his easy-going manner, his deep ambling voice and his willingness to share with his audience. "The blues are the facts of life, the blues are a feeling. It gives me and my listeners a place to testify from the heart," he says.

Stauffer also performs for his blues brothers and sisters in the celebrated Elwood Splinters Blues Band.
