In April 2009, NPR will end its weekly broadcast of *This I Believe* essays on NPR. During an unprecedented four years on NPR, the series has engaged listeners in a discussion of the core beliefs that guide their daily lives. The original vision for *This I Believe* was that it would be a one-year project, and the fact that it has continued for four years is a testimony to the overwhelming listener participation in the series (more than 60,000 essay submissions to date), support from local stations, and the strength of the NPR/TIB collaboration.
