I. Minutes of November 18, 2015 meeting unanimously approved

- II. Development Committee Report
 - 1. Next drive: March 3-9, will focus on new sustaining memberships.
 - 2. Friends made 500 calls to thank new and renewing members from December drive.
 - 3. Major Giving, up \$2500 over this time last year due to Board calls which resulted in 16 gift increases and \$8400 additional income. 65% of major donor budget has been received. \$70k in planned giving recently received.
 - 4. Grants: 65% over budget goal for the year
- III. Finance Committee Report
 - 1. Sustaining members: prior monthly credit card installations about \$19k per month, now \$71k per month
 - 2. Revenue up 11% over past year
